

Steps In Submitting FD Score

- Collect .adi file from FD Logger
- Collect paper and photo verification for bonus points
- Create .sum file and .dup file from FD Logger
- Complete online .bh4 applet with score and bonus points at www.b4h.net/cabforms. Data for this is found in the .sum file.

- Scan visitors log, message to SM, media confirmation, FD message.
- Separate out alternative mode power contacts from log.
- Include photo confirmation for natural power mode, visitors table etc.
- Include everything in one folder, zip and email to fieldday@arri.org

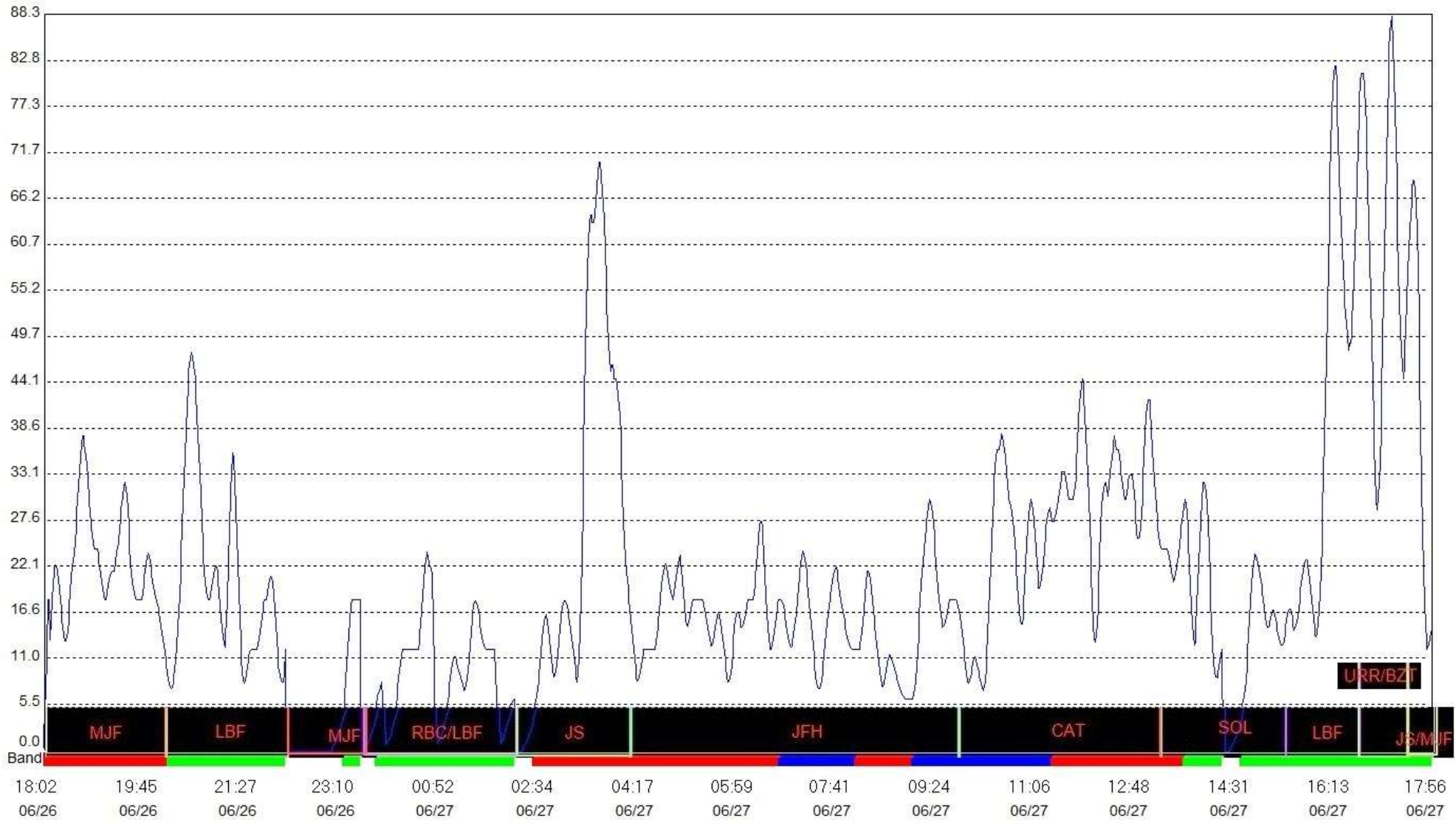

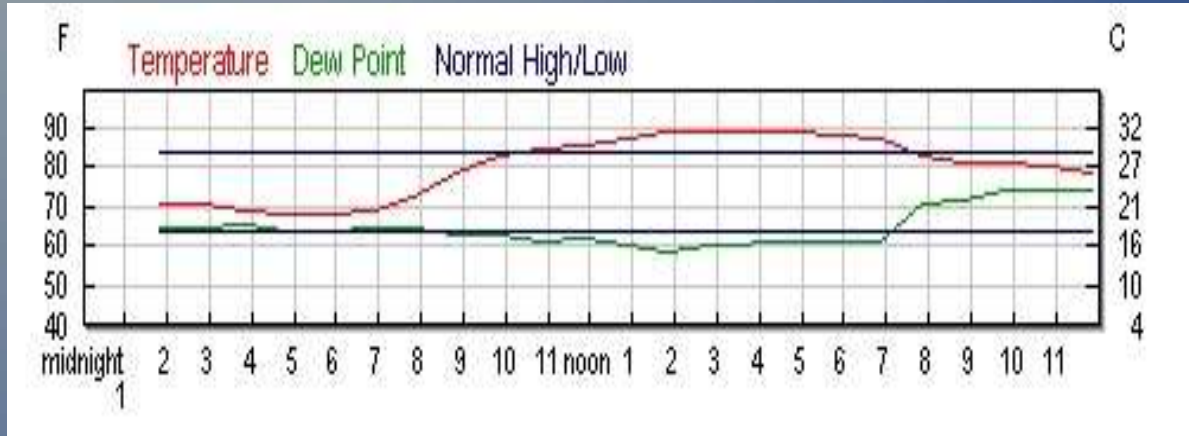
